- Approval of the 2017 general assembly minutes

- President Report; the president, Pamela Habibovic, addressed the assembly to:
  - present the current council members, as well as their duties within the council and their expected period in office;
  - report on activities related to current status of the field of biomaterials in Europe in which she and other members of the council participated in representation of ESB;
  - report on ongoing collaboration activities with sister societies;
  - congratulate the SSB+RM on the re-affiliation with the ESB;
  - congratulate the 2018 Scientific Awardees.
- New membership scheme update; the President reported:
  - the implementation of the new membership scheme in 2018;
  - the current number of members of ESB that was approximately 900 at the date of the General Assembly;
  - that the large majority of members obtained membership through registration for the conference; only a small percentage obtained membership through registration on the ESB website (informed that in case of double membership reimbursement will take place);
  - that with the increase in the number of members, ESB will be able propose new fellows for the IUSBSE (call for proposals will be circulated in due time).

- Treasurer Report (continuation)


- Marc Bohner was given the word again to present a budget for the total of expenses in 2018 and a budget 2019 that has been unanimously approved;

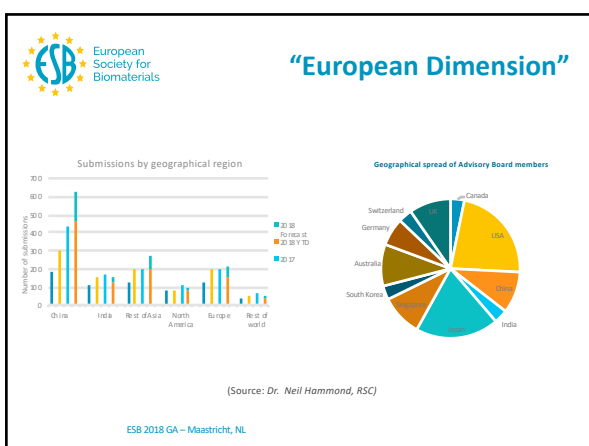


