



- Re-nomination of candidates is possible












### **10 years of Biomaterials Science**


### The first issue of *Biomaterials Science* was published on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2012

Since then the journal has:

- Published over 3000 articles from researchers in over 70 countries (~20% Europe)
- Partnered with ESB (since 2017)
- Awarded an annual journal lectureship (since 2014) to honour an early-stage scientist who has made considerable contributions to the field
- Organised 4 Emerging Investigator special issues and now the ongoing Emerging Investigator Series – recognising over 120 future leaders in biomaterials


