

YSF Call for Projects - 2026

The YSF-ESB Call for Projects supports events and workshops that help train young scientists and share biomaterials knowledge in Europe. For 2026, we have an increased total budget of €1,700. The maximum support for a single project remains at €1,200. This increase means that the YSF should be able to sponsor more than one event, depending on the quality of applications and requested budgets.

Now it is all up to you! The call for events/workshops to be organised in 2026 will be open soon (**Submission deadline: 31 January 2026**).
