Unfortunately, due to travel restrictions and social distancing rules, the organizers were forced to take the difficult decision to postpone the congress to a later date. WBC2020 will now take place from **11-16 December 2020**, and will, as originally planned, be held at the SEC in Glasgow, Scotland.

But there is also some good news! To bring together the biomaterials scientists around the globe, the WBC2020 organizers will soon be launching the Online WBC Community and Virtual Meetings platform. All existing WBC registrants will be auto-enrolled into the WBC online community and will benefit from all of the features of the platform including sessions broadcast live from WBC20202 during our online World Biomaterials 2020 Festival week. Additionally all registrants will enjoy access to the WBC online community for a period of two years as part of their 2020 registration fees.

So, let us stay virtually connected, until we meet again in person, hopefully in December 2020 in Glasgow!
