The winner of the **2024 George Winter Award** is <u>Professor Aldo R. Boccaccini</u>. The George Winter Award was established to recognise, encourage and stimulate outstanding research contributions to the field of biomaterials.

The winner of the **2024 International Award** is <u>Professor Jason Burdick</u>. The International award was established as a recognition of scientists who have generally spent their career outside Europe, who have been internationally respected, have a high scientific profile, and have made major contributions to the field of biomaterials.

The winner of the **2024 Klaas de Groot Award** is <u>Professor Geoff Richards</u>. The Klaas de Groot Award was established as a prestigious recognition of scientists who have shown a distinct ability to provide excellent mentorship and guidance to young researchers, helping them to establish their own independent careers.

Congratulations to all awardees on this great achievement! The 2024 awardees for the George Winter and Klaas de Groot Awards have been invited to deliver a lecture at the next annual meeting of our society that will take place September 7-11, 2025, in Torino, Italy.
