2. YSF call for projects 2022

The call is now open for a new round in 2022. If you are a young ESB member (under 40 years old) and you are interested in receiving financial support to organize national or European events in 2022 for the training of young scientists and science dissemination, consider this as an additional tool to boost the success of your event.

YSF-ESB sponsors the organization of events/workshops for a total amount up to 1,200 Euros. YSF may decide to partially sponsor the requested amount, depending on the number of selected applications and evaluation given to the applications. National Chapters (NC) representatives of the Young Scientist Forum are especially encouraged to apply, but also any other YSF-ESB member (under 40 years old) can send an application. In this case, it is mandatory to contact the NC, before sending the application.

Please note that the deadline for the submission of the project on this call is 31st January 2022 and proposal should be sent at ysf@esbiomaterials.eu.

3. ESB Education awards

The deadline for the application to the ESB education awards is approaching!
The European Society for Biomaterials sponsors two education awards dedicated to young scientists. The deadline for the <u>Julia Polak European Doctorate Award</u> and the <u>Racquel LeGeros Award</u> is **31st January 2022**.

- Julia Polak European Doctorate Award. The award is a scientific recognition for the obtainment of the PhD degree. The award is given by the ESB council and presented during the Annual conference of the Society; the winners will receive a certificate of merit. Requirements and the application form can be found on the <u>ESB website</u>.
- Racquel LeGeros Award. This award is given to two graduate students per year who would like to pursue their research in International/European academic laboratories or companies dedicated to biomaterials and

regenerative medicine. The aim is to increase the knowledge in a specific topic and/or a technology. The application should be sent to secretary@esbiomaterials.eu, by following the instructions provided on the ESB website.
