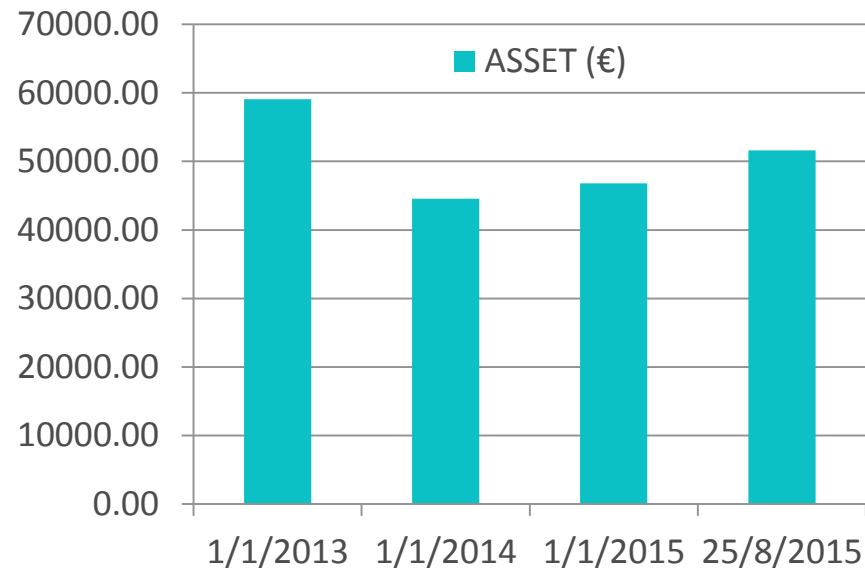

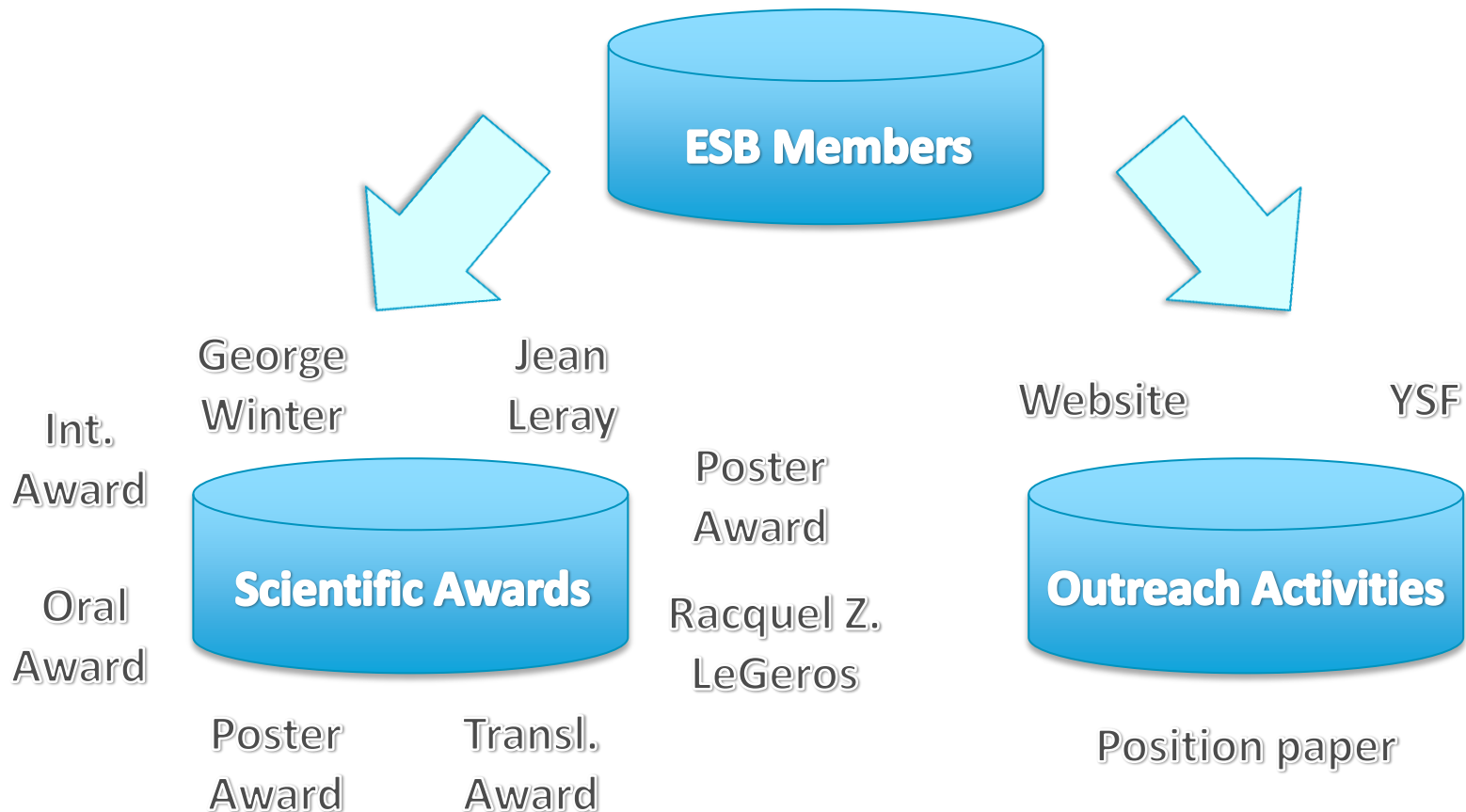
ESB financial situation

- The ESB financial situation throughout previous years



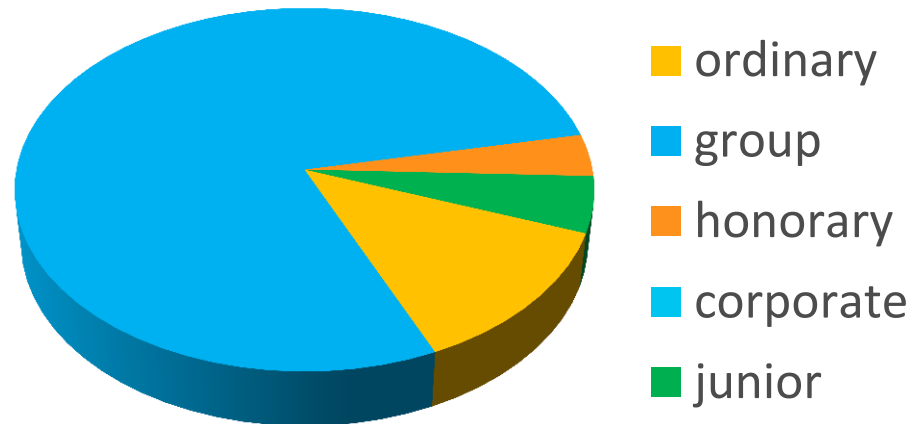
