TERMIS EU congress 2025 | 19 - 23 May 2025, Freiburg, Germany

As part of the memorandum of understanding between the European Society for Biomaterials and the Tissue Engineering and Regenerative Medicine International Society-European Chapter (TERMIS-EU), we would like to announce that the TERMIS-EU congress will be held from 19 - 23 May 2025 in Freiburg, Germany.

Professors Bernd Rolauffs, Melanie Hart, Günther Schlunck, and Thorsten Steinberg, are hosting the event as congress chairs and serving as joint programme chairs.

The global TERMIS promotes tissue engineering and regenerative medicine worldwide to generate knowledge and contribute to improving patient outcomes.

The <u>TERMIS-EU congress</u> aims to bridge the gap between theory and application with hands-on training sessions demonstrating the clinical use of biomaterials and tandem discussions, where clinical demands and basic scientific realities converge to create a more rounded perspective in tissue engineering and regenerative medicine. The congress topics range from a cell- and tissue-specific focus to biomaterials to other highly <u>interesting specialist areas</u>.

2024 Call for Nominations: Biomaterials Advances Innovation Award

Biomaterials Advances will give two Innovation Awards in 2024 to recognize the innovative work of scientists in the field of biomaterials, and is now openly calling for nominations.

About the Award

The Biomaterials Advances Innovation Award recognizes innovative research in the field of biomaterials with the potential to make an impact beyond academia. We seek outstanding research that (1) has contributed to or is likely to contribute to solving an unmet clinical need or; (2) has been or is likely to be adopted by industry or; (3) that demonstrates a concept that will change policy.

Nomination is open for all candidates who have published with Biomaterials Advances (including our previous name Materials Science and Engineering C). A joint Awards Ceremony will be hosted at TERMIS EU 2025, where winners of the Biomaterials Global Impact Award and Biomaterials Award for Young Investigator from the journal Biomaterials will also be recognized. Awardees will have the opportunity to receive their awards and showcase their recent work at the ceremony.

Awardees will also be invited to contribute a perspective article to Biomaterials Advances.

How to Apply

Candidates are required to provide the contact information of a referrer who may be contacted to discuss their qualifications. Nominations should be submitted by completing the online nomination form by September 30th, 2024.

The nomination information will only be used for the administration of the Awards. Full Terms and Conditions are available here.

Prizes

Each winner will receive:

- An honorarium of USD 2,000
- Free registration to TERMIS EU 2025, where the award ceremony will be held
- Inclusion of their article in a collection of winners' articles published in the journal, which will be open for free access for 6 months

Winners will be selected by the editorial team of journal Biomaterials Advances.
